- Review your four-year plan with your counselor

 - Use it for practice — your 11th grade score counts for scholarships.
- Start looking at career paths and majors
 - Use free tools like BigFuture or YouScience to explore options.
- Pursue leadership or deeper involvement
 - Take initiative in one or two key clubs or programs.
- Track achievements and volunteer work
 - Keep updating your brag sheet with dates, roles, and outcomes.
- Start building relationships with teachers
 - You'll need recommendations junior year — be a memorable student.
- Visit a nearby college or attend a virtual tour
 - Get a feel for different types of campuses and programs.
